1.2 ACROBATIC AGE GROUP 11 – 16 PROGRAMME / only individual competition

The 11 – 16 years European Age Group Games will be run in accord with the 2010 – 2012 rules and 2009 FIG Code of Points. Only one partnership from each Federation, in each category can proceed to the final.

- 2 judges EUROPEAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS JUNIORS
- **or** 2 judges seniors + juniors together.

8. TRANSPORT

The travel to Rzeszów will be at each delegation's own expenses.

Accredited team delegations who will book their accommodation through the Organizing Committee and who will fill in their travel schedule form /arrivals and departures by the deadline of 28th September, 2010 will be provided with local transport from the official arrival place /airport [Rzeszow-Jasionka Airport], train station, bus station/ to the official hotels and back.

A regular transport – Hotel to venue – for all participant will be organized by means of buses or mini-buses /by "Marcel" Company/.

Transport will be available for UEG Officials, UEG ACRO TC.

Federations who do not book their accommodation through the Organizing Committee will NOT be entitled to use the transportation system and will be responsible to be on time. No lunch and no banquet are included either.

9. ACCREDITATION AND FIG LICENCES

The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the Championships and ensures controlled access to each area. All participants and officials are required to wear Accreditation Cards at all times, failure to do so may cause participants to be refused entry.

The FIG The Licences must be presented at accreditation. Gymnasts who do not present a valid FIG Licence are not allowed to compete. Should a gymnast not be able to show his Licence at accreditation, a member of the UEG may check on the official FIG Website if the respective gymnast has a valid Licence or not. Should a gymnast present an invalid licence or the validity of the forgotten Licence may not be verified by the UEG, the gymnast shall not be allowed to compete.

At accreditation the Heads of Delegation must,

- check the correct names of their complete delegation
- verify accommodation requirements
- make the necessary payments
- hand in the music cd's of the competitors
- hand in tariff sheets [pictorial declarations for all competitors]
- present the passports of all competitors and judges for the control of Nationality and age
- FIG license details

The accreditation is,

- personal
- non transferable and compulsory to gain access to training and competition hall, functions and official transport.

As far as the number of accreditations per federations is as shown in the FIG Technical Rules and Regulations, and confirmed in the Invitation.

10. PASSPORT PHOTOS

Together with the Nominative registration, the Delegations must forward one passport photo of each delegation member to the Organising Committee. Passport photos are accepted in digital format <u>only</u> and must be sent directly to the Organising Committee. The specification of the photo must be as follows: [echacroteam2010@gmail.com].

- File format: .jgp, jpeg or tiff
- Dimensions; 210 pixels wide x 270 pixels high (portrait ratio 7: 9)

Please forward the passport photo as soon as possible, but no later than 1st October 2010.

An earlier receipt would be much appreciated. If a photo has to be taken in Rzeszow because none has been sent, there will be a charge to the federation of 30 PLN per person.

11. MEDIA AND MEDIA CONFERENCES

Media representatives (journalists, photographers, TV) must request a special accreditation from the OC. Please contact the OC as soon as possible. The media will be assigned special seating and working conditions.

12. ORIENTATION MEETINGS

The orientation meeting for the

- Age Group competition will take place on Tuesday, October 19th.
- Juniors and Seniors will take place on Thursday, October 21st.

These meetings are for the Heads of delegation and team managers. The presence of the participating national federations to the orientation meeting is mandatory. A maximum of 3 members per delegation is recommended, at the federation's choice. Meetings will take place in the Conference Room of the Competition Hall. Further meetings of the OC with the Heads of Delegations and the UEG / TC ACRO may be called if necessary.

13. JUDGE'S INSTRUCTIONS

- The Age Group Games judge's instructions will take place on Tuesday, 19th of October in the Judges Room.
- The Juniors and Seniors Judges' instructions will take place on Thursday, 21st of October in the Judges Room. This is compulsory, judges not participating will not be allowed to judge.
- Judge's meeting will also take place before each session, and a brief meeting may be called at the end of competition.

14. JUDGES PANELS

Superior Jury and Jury of Appeal will be established before the competition. Chairs of Judges Panels and Difficulty Judges will be established before the competition.

15. TRAINING PLAN-WARM UP

The training schedule will be given to the Heads of Delegation upon arrival.

16. COMPETITION SCHEDULE-ROTATIONS

The detailed competition schedule including the rotations will be given upon arrival.

18. OPENING CEREMONY

- Age Group Games Wednesday, 20th of October Competition Hall.
- Juniors and Seniors on Friday, 22nd of October Competition Hall.
- Competitors and coaches will be requested to participate at the Opening Ceremony.
 Seniors and Juniors must wear National tracksuit. Further details will be given at the Orientation Meeting.

19. MEDAL AWARD CEREMONY

The medal winners only will be invited to participate in the medal award ceremony. They are requested to appear in competition attire.

Team – All medal winning teams / 7 or 10 competitors / plus 2 coaches.

20. COMPETITION ATTIRE - PUBLICITY

Please pay attention to the technical regulations (National emblem) and the Guidelines for Advertising and Publicity. Please note that publicity on the competition attire must be approved by the UEG. An opportunity will be given to the Heads of Delegation to present their competition attire for *Publicity* approval on.

21. ATHLETES MEASURING

The athletes measuring will take place on

- Age Groups Tuesday, 19th of October.
- Seniors and Juniors on Thursday 21st of October.

All competitors are requested to present themselves at the **Medical Room** immediately before or after their training session / UEG TC - OC Doctor.

Athletes failing to cooperate with the measuring procedure will incur the penalty as shown in article 6.19 FIG Code of points.

22. MUSIC

The music compact discs two (CD, MD) must be given to the Organising Committee upon arrival at accreditation as per the norms given in the FIG Code of Points.

The following information must be written on the CDs:

- Federation (Country abbreviation)
- Name of competitors
- Category (MP–WP–MXP–MG–WG)
- Type of Exercise (Balance–Dynamic–Combined)
- Type of recording (mono/stereo)
- Title of the music
- The composer(s) of the music used
- Total time (in minutes and seconds) from the first to the last tone of the music.
- The Head of Delegation must sign the form (sent with the directives) on behalf of the competitor:
- Approval of the technical criteria for playing the tape by the OC.
- Confirmation that the music used does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcast within sports.
- For training in the training locations, the competitors will have to bring their personal (third) copy of their music CDs.

23. PICTORIAL DECLARATIONS OF EXERCISES

Pictorial declarations must be handed in by the Heads of Delegation at accreditation. They must be completed,

- in the order in which the elements will be performed,
- showing the page, number and value,
- incomplete sheets will be returned to the team judge.
- ONE copy is required
- The deadline for Age Groups is at acreditation
- The deadline for Senior and Junior Teams is at acreditation
- Late submission will incur a **penalty** in accordance with FIG Code of Points.

VERY IMPORTANT

Please note that only elements in the FIG Tables of Difficulty 2009 or approved supplement are allowed. Elements not meeting this criteria will not be given value at these Championships.

24. INSURANCE

The FIG Technical Regulations foresees that all participating Nations are responsible by themselves for having the necessary insurance coverage of all participants against accidents and illness.

The Organizing Committee will verify the insurance of all countries at accreditation.

25. MEDICAL SERVICES

The Organizing Committee will provide medical services. A doctor will be at your service during training and competitions.

26. DOPING CONTROL

Doping controls will be made during the Championships as per FIG and IOC regulations. The appropriate authority under supervision of the UEG will carry these out. The doping controls can take place during the training, qualifications and/or the finals.

27. VIDEO RECORDING

All routines will be recorded on video.

28. VISA

Please check immediately with your travel agent or Polish Embassy in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Poland .
